* Customer must remove siphon tube from the supply valve of the liquid CO2 tank to have vapor, and attach an in line moisture trap. (sold separately)

*A moisture trap is recommended with all air sources except nitrogen.

Installation

- 1. Remove the Auto-Fill System, hold-down device and scale platform from the shipping containers.
- 2. Mount Auto-Fill System console to wall using the four brackets on the exterior of the console.
- 3. Place the hold-down device in the fill area and then place the scale platform on the base plate of the holddown device. The base plate of the hold-down device and the scale platform should not be more than three feet high off the ground and not less than two feet.
- 4. Adjust the feet on the bottom of the scale platform so it is level and sits firmly.
- 5. Connect the serial cord from the scale platform to the bottom of the weight indicator (see page 5).
- 6. Plug the power cords for both the weight indicator and the Auto-Fill console into an appropriate 110 volt AC outlet.
- 7. Insert 3/8" white poly tubing to the fitting on the top of the console by pushing the air line into the left fitting (marked 'in'). Attach opposite end of this 3/8" tubing to air compressor or regulator. Recommended incoming air pressure should be between 60 80 psi.
- 8. Insert a second 3/8" white poly tubing into the right fitting (marked 'out') on top of the console. The other end of this tubing should be connected to the top fitting on the red console. See drawings on pages 4-5.

* DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MODIFY OR CHANGE ANY OF THE ELECTRONICS OR <u>PROGRAMMING OF THE AUTO-FILL CONSOLE</u>

Filling Instructions

- 1. Set the toggle switch on the red console to the 'On' position.
- 2. Turn the 'Switch' on the Auto-Fill console to the 'Auto' position. *
- 3. With the empty cylinder on the scale with fill cone and red bar in place, set the scale to zero. Do not press down on the red bar. Simply let the weight of the red bar rest on top the fill cone to secure it to the cylinder.
- 4. Push the Green button for the appropriate dry chemical weight. The system will turn on and shut off automatically when the correct weight is reached.

* When filling cylinders other than 5, 10, or 20 lb sizes, turn the 'Switch' on the Auto-Fill console to 'Manual'.

Many factors affect the performance of the Auto-Fill Station so it is conducive to set up your unit similar to how we have conducted our testing to achieve the same performance results in fill times and accuracy.

• Mount the ring bracket for the fill line near your scale approximately 4-5 feet from the ground. If you are filling from a 450 lb Fill Station the ring bracket can remain on the red stand. The scale should be on a workbench or stand approximately 3 feet from the ground. Using a pony clamp at the ring bracket is recommended to hold the fill line in place.
